Photo quality is very important - Image size: minimum 300dpi at A5 size A photo of high quality gives a professional appearance in the publication and it is strongly recommended the use of a professional photographer. If using a digital camera, set at the maximum, and the least amount of compression - no less than 6 mega pixels.	2. Things to consider when taking the photo: a) Check the background, lighting, shadows, etc b) Position of the horse with the near side facing the photographer c) Ensure the entire horse is in the picture (hooves, ears, tail are included plus allow extra background (can be cropped if necessary))
